

COMMUNITY HEALTH FEES AND CHARGES

2021 - 2022

When you arrive

You will need to register and pay at the reception desk as soon as you arrive for your appointment. In order to calculate the appropriate fee, we ask that you show us your Pension and/or Health Care Card, if you have one. If you receive a TDHS service in the community – such as at home, in Simpson or Cobden – we will send you an invoice at the end of the month.

What you will pay

Fees are based on your income and ability to pay. TDHS will not exclude anyone from receiving services due to financial hardship.

How we can help

If you have any concerns about your ability to pay, please talk with your treating health professional who will provide you with information about applying for a reduction. To support low income clients with complex needs, TDHS has set a cap of two paid fees per week. This means that you only pay two fees per week, any other services that week will be free. From **Thursday 1 July 2021** Timboon and District Healthcare Service will be charging the following fees for our health and wellness services:
