

ALLIED HEALTH FEES AND CHARGES

When you arrive

You will need to register and pay at the reception desk as soon as you arrive for your appointment. In order to calculate the appropriate fee, we ask that you show us your Pension and/or Health Care Card, if you have one. If you receive a TDHS service in the community or at home, we will send you an invoice at the end of the month.

What you will pay

The following fees apply to general publicly funded Allied Health services. Please refer to program specific fee schedules for funded programs such as Support at Home, Transport Accident Commission (TAC), Workcover. These Schedule are accessible via our website.

Fees are based on your income and ability to pay. TDHS will not exclude anyone from receiving services due to financial hardship.

If you have any concerns about your ability to pay, please talk with your treating health professional who will provide you with information about applying for a reduction.
